### Caution

1. A student can apply for the following benefits:
  - social scholarship
  - scholarship for disabled persons
  - allowance
  - Rector's scholarship
2. Benefits are available for first-cycle studies, second-cycle studies and uniform master's studies.
3. Benefits are not available to a student holding a degree:
  - Master's degree, Master of Engineering or equivalent,
  - Bachelor's degree, engineer's degree or equivalent if he or she is re-entering a first degree programme.
4. The social scholarship, scholarship for disabled persons and the rector's scholarship shall be awarded for a semester or an academic year.
5. Allowance may not be granted more than twice in an academic year.
6. A student studying simultaneously in more than one field of study may receive benefits only in one field of study indicated by the student.
7. The total period for which benefits are payable is 12 semesters, irrespective of the student's intake, with the proviso that within this period benefits are payable for studies:
  - first degree - not longer than 9 semesters
  - second degree - not longer than 7 semesters.
8. The total period indicated in para. 7 is increased by 2 semesters if the student has undertaken a single master's degree programme whose duration as stipulated by the law is 11 or 12 semesters.
9. The period referred to in paragraphs 7 and 8 shall include all semesters of study started by the student, including semesters falling during the period of leave of absence, with the exception of semesters of consecutive first-cycle study started or continued after the first bachelor's, engineer's or equivalent degree has been obtained.
10. In the case of training in more than one course of study, semesters taken concurrently are treated as one semester.
11. Where a disability has arisen during the course of study or after the award of a degree, the disability grant shall be available for an additional period of 12 semesters, taking into account the provisions indicated in paragraphs 7 and 9.
12. A student applying for or receiving a maintenance grant, scholarship for disabled persons and rector's scholarship shall immediately notify the university of the occurrence of a circumstance resulting in the loss of entitlement to the benefit.
