In the University ranking Perspektywy - WSB University won the third place in Poland. 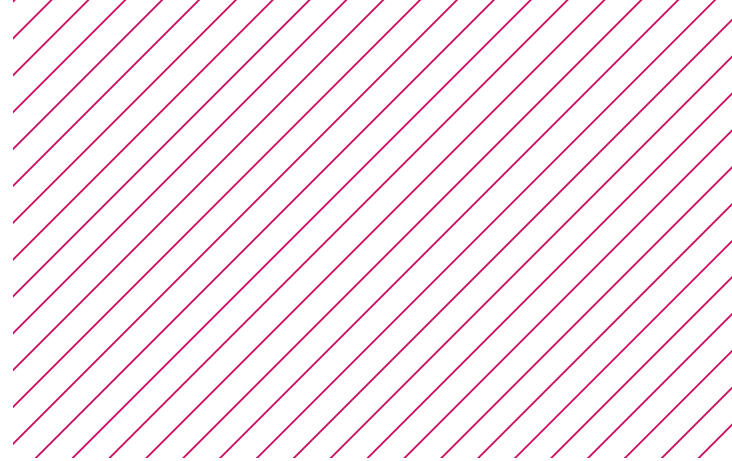


PhD Seminar in Management



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BENEFITS:

- individual cooperation with a research supervisor
- a modular education program adapted to the area of the doctoral student's research interests, implemented remotely
- methodological support: scientific seminars, methodological workshops, content tutoring and consultations with industry experts
- support in the field of international research activity: participation in international conferences, publications in foreign journals, the possibility of participation in international panels of doctoral students, lectures and workshops with professors from foreign research centers, involvement in research projects conducted by the university, publications in international journals

SCHOLARSHIPS

WSB University provides with financial support throughout the whole period of studying. The financial support is offered in the form of scholarships, e.g. social scholarships (for those who have a more difficult financial situation, Rector's scholarship for the 10% of the best students of the given field).

WORK & STUDY

You can get a job during your university study. The Polish law permits International students to look for employment and work up to 40 hours weekly, as long as they are full-time students.



However, since the workload is big at the beginning of studies many students do combine work with study choosing to work part-time, e.g. 20 hours per week, as learning in a foreign language is time-consuming and involves considerable effort.

Facilities

LABORATORY FACILITIES

Modern technology is also present in language laboratories, where teachers use interactive white boards, professional software, and online materials during their classes and lectures. IT laboratories contain high-tech computers and other specialized devices for students of IT and programming.

An exceptional translation laboratory enables the development and training for prospective translators. The translation and interpreting trainers can simulate real-life situations, which are often challenging and generate problems. Thus, the practice becomes a priceless experience.



Sports facilities



The Academy provides the opportunity of using sport facilities (fitness club and gym) which are located on the Academy premises. The Student Sport Association is established within WSB University (AZS WSB).

The university offers its students the opportunity to pursue their sport passions in 44 sport sections, both in team, and individual sports. Apart from sport, AZS WSB is also involved in the promotion of tourism and recreation among university and high school students in Dąbrowa Górnicza, organizing ski trips, mountain hiking, team sports tournaments and cultural events.

- free fitness club



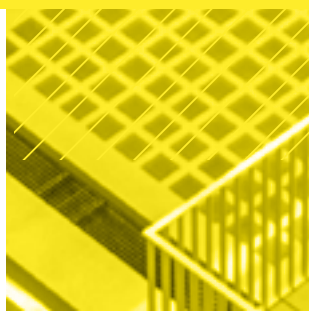
IT FACILITIES

Multiple internet posts and free internet connection are also at students' disposal. Class schedules, dates of tests and exams, as well as other announcements are posted online in an information service for students called Wirtualny Dziekanat (Virtual Dean's Office).

MODERN TEACHING METHODS

During the classes lecturers use modern active teaching methods. Classes are conducted in the form of lectures, workshops, case study analyses, simulations and discussions. The teachers are professional, keeping abreast of effective teaching methodologies for greater learning achievement among the learners.

Adequate knowledge and understanding of modern teaching approaches will enable you to know in what situation and when to use particular methods to maximize the effects on learning outcomes. Your learning process as well as teachers' work is supported by modern technologies at all times.





LIBRARY

You can comfortably freely available use the University's library, which is equipped not only with all the necessary books and scientific magazines, but also with a collection of digital media, such as films, audiobooks, and learning software.

There is also a multimedia reading room at students' disposal, where it is possible to photocopy, scan or photograph materials. Students have the access to online sources there, too books and magazines available in the reading room cannot be borrowed.

If you want to borrow books you have to:

- Register via the electronic catalog OPAC
- Activate your library account by visiting the Main Library and having a valid student's card or an ID with you
- Search books in the electronic catalog
- Order books via the catalog
- Ordered books are ready to take at the library counter within 15 minutes



Important formal information

FEES – FROM 1200€ FOR ACADEMIC YEAR

Tuition fees for the first semester/year are Promotional and vary from tuition fees for next semesters. Tuition fees for next semesters are regulated by Rector's Orders.

The range of tuition fees for next semester is usually 1200€ (depends on exchange rate for academic year). Starting from 3rd semester students have a possibility to pay fees in instalments (monthly).

SECONDARY SCHOOL CERTIFICATE

It is necessary to provide original high school certificate with transcript and proper translation into Polish or English Language. Apart of it certificate should state that the certificate entitles to apply for admission to degree programmes at universities.

If not than separate document will be needed signed by the representative of your secondary school or any other education unit which is in charge of secondary education in your home country.



LEGALIZATION / APOSTILLE

In any case of secondary school certificate it will be necessary either to legalize or apostille the document. Contact our admission advisor for candidate of particular nationality.


In refer to candidates with bachelor or master degree it is necessary to apostille the diploma.




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Admission documents

ADMISSION DOCUMENTS ARE ACCEPTED IN THE FOLLOWING LANGUAGES: POLISH, ENGLISH

1. Scan of secondary school certificate including the transcript of records along with the official translation into English or Polish language with legalization (or apostille) with annotation (or as a separate document) stating that the certificate entitles to apply for admission to degree programmes at universities of every type in the country in which you received the above mentioned certificate.
 2. Scan of your bachelor diploma including the transcript of records along with the official translation into English or Polish language with legalization (or apostille).
 3. Scan of international passport page with your photo and personal data.
 4. One personal photograph in .jpg format along with one photograph in paper version.
 5. Health and Accident insurance policy covering the period of your education in Poland.
 6. Confirmation of payment of tuition fee.

Candidate must bring the original admission documents along with you when you finally arrive to the university.

Legalisation of foreign documents of education (secondary school leaving certificate and higher education diploma) it is a formal verification of their authenticity. If a country in which a given document was issued is not party to the Hague Convention, the documents legalisation remains the responsibility of a Polish consular office in that country.

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
