HEIsCITI responds to the following needs


- 1. To improve educational programmes and curricula at universities on communication between citizens and local/regional authorities on sustainable and inclusive urban development
- 2. To create interdisciplinary programmes at universities to improve soft skills in communication and in animating civic engagement and cooperation between local authorities and citizens
- 3. To develop responsible citizenship among students in Europe
- 4. For inclusive and environmentally friendly development on European abandoned/unused/ unfriendly areas and infrastructures
- 5. To involve citizens in sustainable urban development
- 6. To improve communication between citizens and local authorities
- 7. To transfer good Asian practices in inclusive and sustainable urban development, but also in efficient and meaningful communication between citizens, local authorities and universities





HEIsCITI responds to the following needs

- 8. To fill the gaps in higher education in terms of programmes developing soft skills focused on responsible citizenship, sustainability and respect for diversity and inclusive action
- 9. To find new ways of civic engagement in the post-covid 19 era
- 10. For intensive social inclusion of people negatively affected by the covid-19 pandemic, i.e. the elderly, the lonely, the homeless, migrants, rehabilitated people, etc.

The target groups of the project

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HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS in Europe with a strong focus on WSB, SMU and MRU - The programme will be implemented at partner universities as a response to the already emerging demand for educational programmes and curricula at universities on communication between citizens and local/regional authorities on sustainable and inclusive urban development.

STUDENTS will gain **soft skills in communication** between citizens and local authorities on urban development. They will also gain knowledge and **experience in animating communication** between citizens and local authorities. They will be more sensitive to responsible citizenship, social inclusion of different groups, climate change and the need for real action to save the environment by adapting abandoned urban spaces.





The target groups of the project

LOCAL AUTHORITIES will receive a toolkit for **communication with the inhabitants** and for urban development according to the needs of the inhabitants and the environment. The labour market will be enlarged by students with strong experience and skills in sustainable urban development activities to engage citizens and to animate cooperation between local authorities and citizens.




