ECTS	Grades at WSB University	GRADE CRITERIUM
A	5,0 bardzo dobry (<i>excellent</i>)	- Excellent achievements that are beyond the programme - Results accepting minor, secondary mistakes
B	4,5 or 4+ dobry plus (<i>very good</i>)	- Achievements above average level with some mistakes
C	4,0 dobry (<i>good</i>)	- Achievements in line with standards - Solid work with an array of visible mistakes
D	3,5 or 3+ dostateczny plus (<i>average</i>)	- Satisfactory achievements but with a substantial amount of deficiency
E	3,0 dostateczny (<i>sufficient</i>)	- Work achievements that fulfill minimum requirement
F	2,0 niedostateczny (<i>fail</i>)	- Credit possible after filling elementary deficiencies in the knowledge required

ECTS Grade	% of successful students normally achieving the grade	Definition
A	10	The use of words like "excellent or good is no longer recommended as they do not fit with percentage based ranking of the ECTS Grade Transfer Scale.
