Important Information

1. Research mobilities may be implemented only with the participation of a Host Researcher affiliated with the selected Host Institution.
2. The planned mobility must be implemented:
 - within an existing international research group; or
 - for the purpose of establishing a new international research group within the Q-Helix Alliance.
3. Due to safety considerations and risk management requirements related to the implementation of international activities, research mobilities shall not be implemented in locations affected by warfare or elevated security risk.
4. As of the date of entry into force of the Open Call Regulations, the restriction referred to in point 3 applies to mobilities implemented on the territory of Ukraine.
5. The Organiser reserves the right to update the list of eligible mobility destinations in justified cases related in particular to safety, force majeure, organisational changes within the Alliance, or changes in Project implementation conditions.
